### **\*PROPOSED ITINERARY – SPAIN**

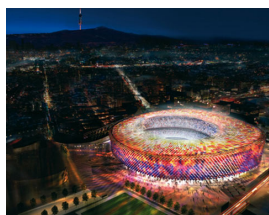
#### **Day One**

- Depart on overnight flight to Spain.

A 1.2 kilometer-long tree-lined pedestrian mall in the Barri Gòtic, it connects Plaça Catalunya in the center with the Christopher Columbus Monument at Port Vell. Usually full of street theatre, cafés and market stalls, it serves as the emotional hub of Barcelona.

- Enjoy an evening kick about on the beach.

#### **Day Five**

- Barcelona Cup Tournament games continue today.
- "Gaudi afternoon" enjoy the works of this great Catalunyan artist. Visits to the Sagrada Familia (the must-see cathedral of Barcelona), Hospital San Pau and Parc Guell.
- Tonight is the Official Reception for participating teams.

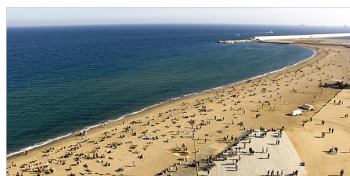
